

# Upper Palmetto YMCA - Guest Policy

## **“IN TOWN” NON YMCA MEMBERS**

Non members living inside York or Chester Counties cannot use the Y for a daily fee. However, 1<sup>st</sup> time visitors living inside York or Chester Counties can get a “1 time” complimentary 1-week pass to the Y AFTER:

1. Taking a tour of Y facilities
2. Completing a YMCA Tour Card
3. Presenting a photo ID (drivers license) to Y staff.

Y Staff are required to enter the guest name into the computer system (precisely as it appears on the photo ID). The 1 week pass must have a beginning and end date – it must be signed by the Branch Director. The guest passes will be given to “family members at home” according to the Guest Tour Information Card. “In town” non Y Members get One 1-week guest pass in a calendar year and it is valid at all of the Upper Palmetto YMCA’s 9 locations during this 1 week period (not one 1-week guest pass per branch). In essence, this is a “try before you buy” offer.

## **“OUT OF TOWN” NON YMCA MEMBERS**

Non members living outside of York or Chester Counties may use the Y for a daily fee - valid ID is required verifying the address of the guest. Youth guest must be registered by an adult when visiting our YMCA.

<u>Daily Fees</u>	<u>Weekly Fees</u>
\$ 5 for youth 18 and under	\$ 20 for individual (all ages)
\$ 10 for adults 19 and older	\$ 40 for a Family

## **“OUT OF TOWN” YMCA MEMBERS**

(Includes Charlotte YMCA Members)

The Upper Palmetto continues to be a part of the YMCA of the USA “AWAY” Program, which allows Y members to use Y facilities in other communities. The Upper Palmetto YMCA allows members of other YMCAs to use their facilities 3 times per month at no cost. If the visiting Y member would like to use the Y more than 3 times each month, the cost is \$ 5 per visit (youth and adult).
